**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COACHELLA,
CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT AN
APPLICATION TO U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (DOT)
REBUILDING AMERICAN INFRASTRUCTURE WITH SUSTAINABILITY AND
EQUITY (RAISE) GRANT PROGRAM IN THE AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED
TWENTY-FIVE MILLION (\$25,000,000) DOLLARS FOR THE CITY'S STATE ROUTE
86 AT AVE 50 INTERCHANGE PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Transportation (“Grantor”) Released a Notice of Funding Opportunity for the submittal of applications for its Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) Grant Program (“Grant”) dated November 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Grant opportunity will hold two rounds of selections: Round 1 – The Department is reserving a portion of the \$1.5 billion in FY 2025 RAISE funds, provided by the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, or BIL), for Highly Rated applications that were not selected under the FY 2024 RAISE NOFO and designated FY 2024 Projects of Merit; Round 2 – The Department will make another round of selections using a portion of the \$1.5 billion in FY 2025 RAISE BIL funds and/or additional funding that may become available for the program under the FY 2025 Appropriations Act; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is in its best interests to submit an application for Round 2 grant program funds to realign and widen Avenue 50 from the existing two-lane roadway to a six-lane major arterial, and realign Tyler Street on both the east and west sides of SR-86; and

WHEREAS, City shall submit an application to the Grantor to participate in the Grant program and for an allocation not-to-exceed \$25,000,000 for its proposed SR-86 at Avenue 50 Interchange Project; and

WHEREAS, the City is familiar with the terms, conditions and limitations of such Grant; and

WHEREAS, the City is willing and able to conform to each of the terms, conditions, and limitations imposed upon any such Grant to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City understands that the Grantor must approve said application and will require the City to execute a Grant Agreement and other necessary documents upon approval; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF COACHELLA, CALIFORNIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1: That the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute an application for Grant funds for the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by the U.S. Department of Transportation.

SECTION 2: The City of Coachella hereby agrees to comply with each and all of the terms, conditions, and limitations imposed by the Grantor upon said Grant, and the City Manager,

or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute any applications, agreements, assurance, extensions, amendments or other documents as may be necessary in connection with acceptance and implementation of said Grant as may be required by the Grantor.
