# 4. Director's Development Update

- RCTC is taking the lead on RFP for the Rail Station Feasibility Study and we will be interviewing consultants for that project at the end of this month and will probably start work in the December. The Planning Commission would be a part of the study that will be a year and a half effort.
- Panda Express will open soon.
- Community Resiliency Center Grant: City is looking into a 10 million dollar grant to rehab the Hidden Harvest Building.
- Proposal for new residential subdivisions will be presented to the Planning Commission in October 18, 2003 for the Sevilla II project, which is 204-unit residential project by Pulte Homes.
- Commissioner Arvizu, requested a study session regarding small business protections. The Commission also discussed the need to review short term rentals.
- ADU Pre-approved plans will be presented to the Planning Commission in the first meeting of November.
