**WHEREAS**, Brenda is also involved in other extracurricular activities like cheer and swim apart from the Ophelia Project; and


**WHEREAS**, Brenda is grateful for the mentors and being able to connect with other girls and also for being able to apply to such an amazing scholarship opportunity; and
