Library Program Spring 2024

Palm Springs Art Museum hosts Family+ every third Sunday of the month where we host community members from 12pm-4pm for various workshops and activities led by local and regional artists. Family+ is free for everyone and includes museum admission. Community members are invited to create art, explore a new medium, and engage with the museum's art collection.

In previous years Palm Springs Art Museum partnered with local libraries to provide art boxes for community members to try new art activities with their families and introduce them to museum events and invite them to monthly Family+ program. This year the education team at Palm Springs Art Museum brought Family+ to three Coachella Valley libraries through *Art in the Library*. Community participants were introduced to Family+ and learned about three different art mediums and about the various events the museum hosts.

Workshops were hosted this spring to invite community members to our Family+ on May 18th, 2024 at Palm Springs Art Museum.

This is in response to the amendments to your organization's Articles of Incorporation filed with the state on August 10, 2005. We have updated our records to reflect the name change as indicated above.


