Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement Between the Coachella/Indio Waste Transfer Station Joint Powers Authority and Tetra Tech BAS, Inc. Project JPA 021518

1. Parties And Date.

This Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement ("Amendment No.1") is made and entered into this 15th day of January 15, 2020 by and between the Coachella/Indio Waste Transfer Station Joint Powers Authority ("JPA") and Tetra Tech BAS, Inc., ("Consultant"). 3. Amendments.

- 3.1 <u>Term of Agreement.</u> Section 3.1.2 of the Agreement is are hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
- 3.1.2 <u>Term.</u> The term of this Agreement shall be from November 1, 2018 February 29, 2020, unless earlier terminated as provided herein. Consultant shall complete the Services within the term of this Agreement, and shall meet any other established schedules and deadlines.
- 3.2 <u>Continuing Effect of Agreement.</u> Except as amended by this Amendment No.1, all provisions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect From and after the date of this Amendment No.1, whenever the term "Agreement" appears in the Agreement, it shall mean the Agreement as amended by this Amendment No.1.
- 3.3 <u>Adequate Consideration.</u> The Parties hereto irrevocably stipulate and agree that they have each received adequate and independent consideration for the performance of the obligations they have undertaken pursuant to this Amendment No.1.
- 3.4 <u>Counterparts.</u> This Amendment No.1 may be executed in duplicate originals, each of which is deemed to be an original, but when taken together shall constitute but one and the same instrument.
