## **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve Resolution authorizing the application submittal for the Fiscal Year 2022 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG), in the amount of \$12,655.

## **EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:**

The County of Riverside has released its Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG). The total funds available to County-wide is \$618,000. The identified maximum per capital allocation the City of Coachella is eligible to receive is \$12,655. This grant does require a 100% match (1 to 1 ratio), thus the total expenditures must total \$25,310 to receive the full allocation available to the City of Coachella.

Staff is recommending requesting these funds for 1) purchase eighteen (18) laptops for the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and 2) to reimburse city for staffing expenses for Emergency Services Coordinator. The eighteen laptops will replace laptops no longer working for the City's Emergency Operations Center; this expense will total \$18,019.00. The recommended submittal for reimbursement of staffing expenses for the Emergency Services Coordinator will total \$7,291; this will reimburse city for County staffing expenses.

## FISCAL IMPACT:

As the match amounts are already budgeted for in the current fiscal year, the recommended actions will have positive fiscal impact.
