SUBJECT: Resolution No. SD-2025-03, Approving the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Coachella

Sanitary District Annual Budget

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Adopt Resolution SD-2025-03 approving the annual budget and organizational structure for the fiscal year 2025-2026 for the Coachella Sanitary District.

BACKGROUND:

The Sanitary District's 2025-2026 budget includes revenues projected at \$8.77 million, which represents a decrease of 14.21% over the prior fiscal year. This results from decreases in interest and other revenues.

District expenditures (net of principal payments) are budgeted at \$8.93 million, which is 17.06% lower than last year. The decrease is due to decreases in administrative costs, operating costs, and inter-fund transfers.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Budget impact in chart on next page. Recommended classification changes are: (1) add one FTE Treatment Plant Operator I, and (2) reclass one-half FTE from Utility Manager to Utility Director. This change occurred in Fiscal Year 2024-25, but was not included in the resolution approving the budget change.
