SUBJECT: Purchase of Millcreek 4300 Turf Tiger Mulch Spreader from Trinity Equipment,

Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$49,997.81.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the purchase of Millcreek 4300 Turf Tiger Mulch Spreader from Trinity Equipment, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$49,997.81.

DISCUSSION/ANALYSIS:

The City applied for a Cal Recycle SB1383 Grant in November 2023 and was awarded for the purchase of a "material spreader" machine to spread composted material throughout the City Parks. The finished compost and mulch is a soil amendment with a wide variety of nutrients, micronutrients, and organic matter, all of which benefit the soil, which will help the City and CalRecycle meet its disposal reduction goals required by SB 1383. Currently, the City utilizes composte thorughout it's parks to meet SB 1383 requirements but has to rent the equipment. Staff has reached out to three vendors and after reviewing their proposals have determined the quote from Trinity Equipment, Inc. is the lowest, responsive bidder. Staff recommends purchasing the Millcreek 4300 Turf Tiger Mulch Spreader from Trinity Equipment. Inc.

FISCAL IMPACT:

No fiscal impact to General Fund. The equipment will be funded partially by Cal Recycle SB1383 Grant in an amount of \$18,053.02. The balance will be split between accounts 101-11-14-30-334-401 and 101-11-148-30-334-404 (Cont Serv/ Bagdouma Park and Cont Serv/Rancho Las Flores Park).
