Chapter XI cont.

No action shall be maintained against the city for damages growing out of such an injury unless the claimant first gives written notice to the council within 30 days after the injury is sustained, stating specifically the time when, the place where, and the circumstances under which it was sustained; and that he will claim damages therefore of the city in the amount which he specifies. Nor shall the action be maintained unless 30 days have elapsed after the presentation of this notice to the council.

Section 43. EXISTING ORDINANCES CONTINUED. All ordinances of the city consistent with this charter and in force when it takes effect shall remain in effect until ammended or repealed.

Section 44. TIME OF EFFECT OF CHARTER. This charter shall take effect July 1, 1950.

Chapter XII

SPECIAL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BOND ISSUE

Section 45. The City of Coburg through its council is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to issue and sell as needed, and as shall be deemed expedient, convenient and necessary by the council, negotiable bonds of the City of Coburg in any amount up to the amount of \$225,000, and to expend the proceeds thereof to make repairs, improvements, additions and extensions to the water system owned by the City of Coburg, and to budget and levy such sums annually as shall be necessary to retire the principal and interest of the bonds when due.
