<b>Program Title:</b>	<b>Local Government Grant Program (LGGP)</b>

<b>Program Purpose:</b>	To award grant fund assistance for outdoor park and recreation areas and facilities, acquisition of property for park purposes, bicycle and pedestrian recreation and transportation trails, bicycle recreation opportunities, and non-motorized water-based recreation.
<b>Eligible Projects:</b>	Property Acquisition, Development, Rehabilitation and Planning
<b>Eligible Applicants:</b>	Cities, Counties, Metropolitan Service Districts, Park and Recreation Dist., and Port Districts
<b>Funding Source:</b>	Oregon Lottery Funds for Natural Resources
<b>Funding Available:</b>	Approximately <b>\$6 million</b> annually
<b>Funding Type:</b>	Reimbursement Grants
<b>Small Grants:</b>	<b>\$75,000</b> maximum award. Application only. No presentation required.
<b>Large Grants:</b>	<b>\$750,000</b> maximum award. ( <b>\$1 million</b> for property acquisitions). Application plus presentation to LGGP Advisory Committee required.
<b>Matching Requirements:</b>	<b>50% match</b> required for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cities and districts with a population over 25,000</li><li>• Counties with a population over 50,000</li></ul> <b>40% match</b> required for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cities and districts with a population between 5,000 and 25,000</li><li>• Counties with a population between 30,000 and 50,000</li></ul> <b>20% match</b> required for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cities and districts with a population under 5,000</li><li>• Counties with a population under 30,000</li></ul>
<b>Planning Projects:</b>	<b>\$40,000</b> maximum award. Application only. No presentation required.
<b>Eligible Planning Grant Applicants:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cities, Park, Recreation and Port Districts with populations less than 10,000, and</li><li>• Counties with populations less than 50,000</li></ul>
<b>Planning Grant Matching Requirements:</b>	<b>20% match</b> required for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cities or districts with a population less than 5,000</li><li>• Counties with a population less than 30,000</li></ul> <b>40% match</b> required for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cities and districts with a population between 5,000 and 10,000</li><li>• Counties with a population between 30,000 and 50,000</li></ul>

<b>September / October</b>	Project Agreements and Notice to Proceed Letters processed
