It was determined that applications for entries would be available online and at local businesses from March 1, 2022-March 31, 2022 with a registration deadline of April 1, 2022. Art entries would then be available to the committee, at its May meeting, for judging. Applications would include guidelines for entries and garden arts, statues, etc., would be acceptable. The committee agreed that the revised poster would need to be completed and posted as soon as possible. Regarding the choice of plaques the committee agreed that should more than one entry be submitted per building they would choose one for final submission.

Looking forward the committee agreed to put the topic of the art contest on the agenda for its February meeting.
