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### REQUESTED COUNCIL ACTION

**Approve Thomas Street Waterline Replacement Project Contract**

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** *"I move to approve the Thomas Street Waterline Replacement Project contract between the City of Coburg and Delta Construction Company."*

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### BACKGROUND

As part of the multi-project Water Master Plan upgrades there have been many undersized Asbestos Cement Pipes identified for replacement. Thomas Street Waterline Replacement Project is replacing 6" pipe with new 8" pipe, new services, new fire hydrant, and the starting point for the rest of the pipe replacement and upsizing moving through the area. There were six construction firms that bid on this part of the Water Master Plan upgrades. Delta Construction Company out of Eugene, Oregon was the low bidder at \$137,163. Once we have an executed or signed contract with Delta Construction Company we can schedule the pre-construction meeting and get their construction schedule.

This project should only take one to two weeks for completion.

The project does call out for one service that is located on another street to be replaced onto Thomas St. This may cause some issues with the Property owner.

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### BUDGET

- The estimated cost of this contract is \$137,163. The funding source for this project is Business Oregon and some Water SDC Funds.

### RECOMMENDATIONS AND ALTERNATIVES

1. Take no action. If the Council chooses this step the contract will not be awarded.
2. Approve the contract as drafted. The contract would become effective immediately and

end with final completion no later than September 15, 2022.

3. Adopt an amended contract. Council may make suggestions for contract changes. However, Council should consider that this contract language is the approved and required language of Business Oregon for the funded water projects.
