# **BACKGROUND**

This project was funded through the MPC (Regional Metropolitan Planning Committee). The project is work for the demolition of existing driveway and construction of new sidewalk and driveway along the south side of W. Van Duyn Street, just east of the intersection of Coburg Bottom Loop Road and W. Van Duyn Street.

### **PURPOSE**

We believe that this project will add another safer route to and from the downtown area to the west end of the City. Connecting the South side of Van Duyn to Coburg Bottom Loop Intersection will also add a continuous sidewalk that would connect most of the Coburg Loop Path system to the Sidewalks in the downtown area. In addition, it continues to build on safe routes to schools.

The south side of W. Van Duyn Street, in the City of Coburg, Oregon, is in need of a sidewalk connection between the south east corner of Coburg Bottom Loop and the existing sidewalk just east of 32534 W. Van Duyn Street existing approach including a new driveway approach for 32534 W. Van Duyn Street. The City will be hiring a contractor to demolish and construct the existing driveway approach and connect the existing sidewalks along the south side of W. Van

Duyn with new concrete sidewalk.

### **BUDGET**

This project was funded through the MPC using state funds. A grant for \$40,000.00 was awarded to the City of Coburg.

# **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Council approve the Contract for the amount of the proposed quote of \$39,419.16 with Roger Langeliers to construct the sidewalk project on Van Duyn St.

#### **NEXT STEPS**

If Council approves the Contract the City of Coburg will work with the contractor to develop a timeline for the project to start and finish.
