BACKGROUND

Several issues have been identified within the current Sign Ordinance A-155-A. The purpose of this set of amendments is to potentially update processes and regulations, particularly those related to the criteria and process for temporary signs and illuminated signs, as well as to clarify outdated or unclear language.

In the attached copy of Ordinance A-155-A, highlighted areas have been color coded to begin the discussion with the Planning Commission on desired changes. The color coding is as follows:

- Green highlights: Staff plans to bring proposed language changes for these sections. Please consider feedback to guide those changes.
- Yellow highlights: Areas that may be problematic and tagged for further review during a more comprehensive update but will not be addressed this time because there is either not an easy fix available or it is not burdensome.
- Red highlights: to be deleted

Staff will present an overview of the highlighted areas at the May meeting.

NEXT STEPS

The focus of this sign code amendment process is for Planning Commission to identify areas of the ordinance where staff should research and develop new language. The May meeting is intended for staff direction. The goal is for Planning Commission to make a recommendation on proposed changes at the July meeting.
