Parks Work Session Notes February 22, 2023

Meeting with Chuck Sheppard went well...he and wife like the idea of fountain; maybe a plaque nearby; mural idea. They have no expectations but appreciate committee ideas. – reported by Mary M. and Lonna M.

Results of community comments:

- Concerns for food vendor's access for set-up at events
- Access available on Harrison St. where new benches and restrooms will be
- Some comments about pathways were negative, but will be explained to public later

Specifics:

Bathrooms – pitched roof to resemble pavilion; back of restroom parallel to Thomas building; doors facing north.

- <u>Interior</u>: light tubes; free-line sinks; stainless sinks and toilets; power hand dryers.
 Changing tables on both sides. Spouts mounted on wall for sink. Small hot water heater; auto-flush toilets; motion sensor lights; concrete floor
- <u>Exterior</u>: try to match pavilion; roof gutters; overhang in front to protect entrance; approach to restroom with slate, (like stone around pavilion)

Pavilion Improvements:

- decorate bottom of posts with stone or stone-look; same with kiosk
- rebuild steps with wood? Concrete? Trex?
- Refinish wood; not sure how
- Improve handrails

Bike Hub:

- Wrap posts with cedar
- Protect bottom of existing posts that are set in concrete

Pathways:

- New pathways will be soft and permeable (ADA) with decomposed granite
- Concrete path from ADA north around raingarden
- Existing paths stay in place
- Path thru urban forest loop back to itself and move that path more into park

Lighting:

- Dark sky along all paths with electrical outlets to use for Christmas decorations
- Outside restroom lights


Children's climbing area

- Tree climber with adjacent logs; material? Design? Placement?



Water presentation features Mural




