## **RESOLUTION 2024-06**

## A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE CITY'S CERTIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE-SHARED REVENUES

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760, provides as follows:

**Section 1.** The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- (1) Police protection,
- (2) Fire protection,
- (3) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting,
- (4) Sanitary sewers,
- (5) Storm sewers,
- (6) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control,
- (7) One or more utility services, and,

**WHEREAS,** City officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Coburg, hereby certifies that it provides the following five services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760: Police Protection; Street Construction, Maintenance, and Lighting; Sanitary Sewer; Planning, Zoning and Subdivision Control; Water Utility Service.
