

RESOLUTION 2026-02

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REVISED WATER RATES

WHEREAS Ordinance A-224-A requires City Council to adopt a schedule of the water rates to be charged for each class of service by Resolution; and

WHEREAS it is the general policy of the Coburg City Council that enterprise funds supporting the operation of infrastructure systems such as the water system should operate on a self-sustaining basis; and

WHEREAS it is necessary and appropriate to update the water service rates to ensure a fiscally sound operating water system, which includes maintaining required debt and infrastructure re-investment reserves, and

WHEREAS the City Council held a public hearing on January 13, 2026 providing public opportunity to comment consistent with ORS 294.160.

THE CITY OF COBURG RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Water Rate Schedule with the rates set forth below incorporating a three and four tenths percent (3.4%) rate increase based on the November 2025 ENR Construction Index will become effective as of April 1, 2026.
