CITY OF COLUMBIA HEIGHTS - COUNCIL LETTER

BACKGROUND:

The police and fire departments have continued to conduct ongoing assessments of security needs for the public safety building. The assessments identified vulnerability in the tempered glass that is currently used in the majority of the outer windows of the public safety building. A recommendation is being made to replace this glass with laminated glass. The city has used this type of glass effectively at city owned liquor stores, and will provide an additional level of protection to prevent unwanted access and intrusion into the public safety building in the event of civil unrest or other disturbances.

Two quotes were obtained and the police and fire departments are recommending approval of the quote provided by Dorglass Inc for \$19,000.00 to replace key perimeter glass of the public safety building. This item was not a planned budget item, but the police and fire department have sufficient funds available in their operating budgets for this item.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Recommend the replacement of tempered glass windows at the public safety building with laminated glass through Dorglass Inc.

RECOMMENDED MOTION(S):

MOTION: Move to approve replacement of windows at the public safety building through the vendor Dorglass Inc for a cost of \$19,000.00
