BACKGROUND

In April the City will kick off its 2050 Comprehensive Plan Update process. To gain input from interested city residents throughout the process, City Council instructed Staff to form a Review Committee made up of city residents as well as Board and Commission members. Once the Committee is formed members will work directly with city staff and consultants to review and advise on all elements of the Comprehensive Plan.

SUMMARY OF CURRENT STATUS

The online application to apply for the Review Committee was available from January 28 to February 23, 2026. Seven engaged city residents applied to be a part of the committee. Three Commissioners have volunteered to be a part of the Review Committee. The intention is to have the committee be made up of 10-12 members including both residents and commissioners. As outreach and engagement regarding the plan increases, staff expect to hold another recruitment period to add additional participants to the committee.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION
