## PARK BUILDING RENTALS

The park buildings at Huset Park East, Ramsdell Park, Keyes Park, and McKenna Park are available for rentals. The fee for residents is \$75, or \$150 for large groups of 100 people or more.

Reservations are made through the Recreation office. Call (763) 706-3730, or visit John P. Murzyn Hall at 530 Mill St NE to make a reservation.

Open-sided picnic shelters are available on a first come, first served basis.

## COMMUNITY GARDEN PLOTS

The City of Columbia Heights manages a community garden with 48 plots that are available for residents to rent during the planting season. The garden is located on Reservoir Blvd near 44th Ave NE.
