A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATIONS TO THE COLUMBIA HEIGHTS FIRE DEPARTMENT

1. The City Council hereby gratefully accepts the following donations on behalf of the Columbia Heights Fire Department:
 - A funeral casket with an estimated value of \$3,500 for use by the Fire Department Honor Guard as a training aid.
 - Seventy-six (76) Kidde DETECT 10-year battery-powered combination smoke and carbon monoxide alarms (Model 30CUD110), with an estimated retail value of \$4,557.72, for use in the department's community risk reduction, public education, and smoke alarm installation programs.
