Good morning—

My family lives on Reservoir Blvd, between 40th and 39th Ave.

Speeding traffic is a big issue for those living on and using Reservoir Blvd for walking/biking. I call CHPD on a frustratingly regular basis to get the speed trap put on our street. That does help slow down traffic while the speed trap is actively visible.

The speed limit is 30mph but vehicles regularly go by over 45mph and it's not uncommon that cars go twice the speed limit (verified by the speed traps). There are lots of young families that live on this road and many pedestrians that use it for walks and to get to bus stops.

With city hall being put in at the end of Gould Ave, traffic coming up reservoir and turning onto Gould will become a bigger issue.

What can we do to get traffic slowed down on Reservoir? Can we get the speed limit reduced like it is in Mpls? Can we add parking bays to parts of Reservoir to slow traffic? Install flashing speed signs?

There are sidewalks from 37th to 41st, so that is my primary area of concern as many pedestrians use that section.
