**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE AGREEMENT WITH AT&T, FOR SWITCHED ETHERNET SERVICE, TO COVER RADIO TOWERS, CERTAIN FIRE STATIONS AND OTHER LOCATIONS SUCH AS PINE GROVE LANDFILL, THE SHERIFF'S TRAINING FACILITY, MUSCOGEE COUNTY PRISON, AND THE RECYCLING CENTER AT A MONTHLY COST OF APPROXIMATELY \$13,000.00 FOR SIXTY (60) MONTHS.**
