CARES Act Intent

 The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and **Economic Security (CARES) Act** was passed by Congress and signed into law on March 27th .This over \$2 trillion economic relief package intends to protect the American people from the public health and economic impacts of COVID-19.

CCG CARES Act Funding

Phase I Allocation:

\$10,248,054.26

30% Advance: \$3,074,416.28

70% Funding: \$7,173,637.98

State made initial 30% allocation deposit on August 3rd and 70% allocation deposit on September 2nd

Had to be expended and submitted by September 1, 2020

Based on per capita basis (population): 195,769

CCG CARES Act Phase II/III Balance = \$24 million

- Columbus State University = \$6.3 million (US DoE)
- Columbus Technical College = \$3.1 million (US DoE)
- Rivertown School of Beauty = \$348k (US DoE)

- Various Medical/Healthcare Providers & Hospitals= \$41.1 million (US HHS)
 - St Francis Health, LLC \$18.6 million
 - The Medical Center (Piedmont) \$7.6 million
- Valley Healthcare System = \$1.1 million (US HRSA)

Housing Authority of Columbus = \$571k (HUD)

Other Allocations Total = \$74.7 million

Grand Total \$108.7 million (including CCG's CARES allocation)
