AGENDA SUMMARY:	The Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) has requested that the city enter into an agreement to handle the negotiations with Mt. Pilgrim Baptist Church for the necessary right of way needed for the I-185/Cusseta/Old Cusseta Road project. This project is funded entirely under the Transportation Investment Act (TIA) of 2012.

Recommendation: Approval is requested to enter into an agreement with GDOT for the city to administer the negotiation process with the Mt. Pilgrim Baptist Church for the right of way needed for the I-185/Cusseta/Old Cusseta Road project.

<u>Background</u>: The I-185/Cusseta/Old Cusseta Road project will be the construction of a new interchange that will provide direct access to I-185 for this area of the community. The project will require the acquisition of certain right of way that will include property owned by Mt. Pilgrim Baptist Church. Because of the sensitivity of the historic church property, GDOT has requested that any acquisition be handled on a local level.

<u>Analysis:</u> The agreement will require the City to handle all negotiations with the church on obtaining any right of way needed for this project.

<u>Financial Considerations</u>: This project is being funded entirely under the Transportation Investment Act (TIA) of 2012.

<u>Legal Considerations:</u> The City Attorney has reviewed and approved the contractual agreement.

Recommendation/Action: Authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with GDOT for the city to administer the negotiation process with the Mt. Pilgrim Baptist Church for the right of way needed for the I-185/Cusseta/Old Cusseta Road project.
