### Finance Report - Corey Neal

- The county funds are being monitored closely and we are stretching until the new fiscal year.
- We have sent over the agency request for appropriation for FY20 to the Columbus Consolidated Government.
- We will be informed of the recommended appropriations for the agency per CCG.

### Emergency Response Unit - Corey Neal

- There will be an American Red Cross training facilitated by Sam Doyle on April 4, 2019.
  - The training will instruct DFCS employees on how to assist with shelter.
- The Emergency Response Unit allows the county to know which individuals are to mandate the shelters.
  - o There are different tiers; tier one, tier two, and tier three.
  - o Corey Neal and Tamara Bowser-Brock goes through the initial first 24 hours.
  - Which allows the initial setup of the system to be intact.

# Office of Family Independence (OFI) Report - Deedre Ligon

- SNAP SOP as of 3/15/19:
  - o Un-Expedite: 81.78%
  - o Expedite: 98.13%
- Staff are in training to learn both program areas.
  - Additional programs result in additional money for staff.

### Permanency Report - Rhonda Wingfield

- PD Wingfield reported that there are currently 424 children in foster care in Muscogee County.
- The permanency staff have an average of 34-48 cases per worker.
- New worker will be done with training on April 1, 2019.
- Muscogee County has finalized 58 adoptions in the last six months.

### Safety Report - Cherry Jones

- PD Jones reported that there are currently 74 open investigations, 160 family support cases, 114 ongoing/family preservation cases, and 4 safety resource cases.
- Both newly hired case managers are in training.
- They will be done with training on May 1.
- The Safety supervisor who volunteered to deploy to Augusta, GA, Amitrice
  Davidson, has returned to Muscogee.

### Director's Report - Jena Jones

- Month of March is National Social Work month.
- This week was "Social Services Week" at the office.
  - Staff participated in numerous events such as muffin day, smoothie day, and luncheon.
- Clement Arts has started a new portal to assist individuals in need in the community.
