What is TIA?

Transportation Investment Act of 2010 (TIA)


- Created 12 special districts along Regional Commission boundaries
- Each district can levy a 1% sales tax for 10 years
- 75% for projects on the approved investment list
- 25% dispersed to counties and cities
- GDOT responsible for ensuring delivery of all projects

- Wynnton Rd/SR 22 Spur to Annette Ave
- Budget: \$10,700,000 (100% TIA Funds)
- Band 1: 2023 2026
- 3-lane typical with sidewalk, trail, and intersection improvements
- Developing traffic projections
- Environmental screenings ongoing
- Next Milestone: Concept Report

Second Ave/SR 85

- Manchester Expy to Talbotton Rd/19th St
- Budget: \$18,200,000 (100% TIA Funds)
- Band 2: 2027 2029
- Streetscape, trail, sidewalk, intersection improvements
- Environmental screenings ongoing
- Next Milestone: Concept Report
- Working with maintenance project (M005022)





River Valley - TIA 2 Pre-Concept Status

JR Allen/US 80 Ramp Improvements

- US 80 @ Blackmon and Schomburg Roads
- Budget: \$11,300,000 (Blended TIA and Federal Funds)
- Band 2: 2027 2029
- Intersection improvements at the four ramp termini
- Intersection analysis recommended roundabouts at intersections
- Environmental screenings ongoing
- Next Milestone: Concept Report

Manchester Expy/US 27 Alt @ County Line Rd

- Budget: \$36,650,000 (Blended TIA and Federal Funds)
- Band 3: 2030 2032
- Interchange reconstruction and bridge replacement
- Developing traffic projections
- Environmental screenings ongoing
- Next Milestone: Concept Team Meeting






River Valley - TIA 2 Pre-Concept Status


University Ave

- Manchester Expressway to Macon Rd
- Budget: \$6,000,000 (100% TIA Funds)
- Band 1: 2023 2026
- Reduce to 2-lanes with bike/ped
- Typical sections determined based on best value and meeting the needs of the project
- Environmental screenings ongoing
- Next Milestone: Concept Report

River Valley - TIA 2 Design Status

Andrews Rd

- Cusseta Rd to Buena Vista Rd
- Budget: \$6,800,000 (100% TIA Funds)
- Band 1: 2023 2026
- Intersection improvements, trail, and sidewalk
- Concept Report approved
- 10' trail from Cusseta to RR, 5' sidewalk from RR to Buena Vista
- Turn lanes at Clover, Alford, and Cusseta
- Environmental screenings ongoing
- Next Milestone: Public Meeting







River Valley - TIA 2 Design Status

Brennan Rd

- Cusseta Rd to Buena Vista Rd
- Budget: \$9,200,000 (100% TIA Funds)
- Band 1: 2023 2026
- Intersection improvements, trail, and sidewalk
- Concept Report approved
- 10' trail from Cusseta to Aldridge, 5' sidewalk from Aldridge to Buena Vista
- Turn lane at Aldridge, center turn lane from RR to Buena Vista
- Environmental screenings ongoing
- Next Milestone: Public Meeting







River Valley - TIA 2 Procurement Status

Williams Rd

- US 27 to I-185
- Budget: \$18,700,000 (100% TIA Funds)
- Band 3: 2030 2032
- Widening, intersection improvements, and pike/ped
- Design contract to be advertised Spring 2025

Cusseta Rd

- 10th Ave to Fort Benning Rd
- Budget: \$17,600,000 (100% TIA Funds)
- Band 3: 2030 2032
- 3-lane typical, intersection improvements, and pike/ped
- Design contract to be advertised Spring 2025
