It is requested that Council approve the Law Enforcement Agreement from LexisNexis CoplogicTM Solutions (Alpharetta, GA) for Desk Officer Reporting System, for 2 years, in the amount of \$21,300 annually for a total cost of \$42,600. The cost of the system will be offset via revenue sharing, whereby by LexisNexis collects the fees paid by individuals to obtain a vehicle crash report and remits \$5 per report to the City for each report sold. The City receives approximately \$44,000 annually through the sale of the vehicle crash reports. This system will be purchased via cooperative purchase via, contract # (Contract Number: 48400-197-DOT0001774-001) between LexisNexis Coplogic and the Georgia Department of Transportation.

Georgia DOT is the designated state agency for managing and storing the states crash reports in the Georgia Electronic Accident Reporting System (GEARS) database. The Columbus Police Department submits accident reports via the GEARS database. When individuals require a copy of an accident report, they must go through the GEARS system, which is maintained by LexisNexis per the GDOT contract. Individuals pay for the reports through Gears and CPD receives \$5 per report which is paid quarterly to the City.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT FROM LEXISNEXIS COPLOGIC™ SOLUTIONS (ALPHARETTA, GA) FOR DESK OFFICER REPORTING SYSTEM, FOR 2 YEARS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,600.
