Project 2 Memorial Stadium Lighting \$780,000.00

Project 3 Bibb City Soccer Complex lights and bathroom renovations \$1,402,949.00

The grant provides an opportunity to provide improvements to parks that might not otherwise receive attention.

<u>Background:</u> The grant was derived by Government Kemp to improve parks and neighborhoods in the state of Georgia.

Analysis: This grant supports neighborhood parks, facilities and playgrounds.
