AGENDA SUBJECT:	Columbus Police Department: Donations
AGENDA SUMMARY:	Approval is requested to accept donations totaling \$6,125 given in support of the Columbus Police Department.
INITIATED BY:	Columbus Police Department

Recommendation: Approval is requested to accept one donation in the amount of \$6,000 and a second donation in the amount of \$125, given in support of the Columbus Police Department.

Background: A check in the amount of \$6,000 was received by the Columbus Police Department from a donor who wishes to remain anonymous. A check in the amount of \$125 was received by the Columbus Police Department from J. F. Evans, Inc. Both donations were given to show their support of the entire Columbus Police Department and was designated to be used as the Department deems appropriate.

Analysis: The Columbus Police Department will deposit the checks in accordance with policy and maintain records and receipts accordingly.

Financial Considerations: The donated funds are for the Columbus Police Department and will be placed within the Department's designated Donation fund.

Legal Considerations: The Consolidated Government of Columbus is eligible to receive the funds.

Recommendation/Action: Approval is requested to accept two financial donations totaling \$6,125 given in support of the Columbus Police Department.
