The purchase will be accomplished by Cooperative Purchase via Georgia Statewide Contract #99999-SPD-ES40199373-005.

The vehicle is a replacement for a vehicle totaled in an accident.

Georgia Statewide Contract #99999-SPD-ES40199373-005 is a cooperative contract whereby Hardy Chevrolet, Buick, GMC, Inc. is one of the awarded vendors contracted to provide Administrative Vehicles, Regular and Alternatively Fueled.
