AGENDA SUBJECT:	Removal & Recycling/Reuse, Scrap Metal, Bulky Items & Similar Material from Columbus Landfill and Other City Locations (Annual Contract) – RFB No. 21-0019
INITIATED BY:	Finance Department

It is requested that Council approve the execution of an annual contract with SA Recycling, LLC (East Point, GA), for the removal and recycling/reuse of scrap metal, bulky items and similar material from the Columbus Landfill, and other City locations of Columbus Consolidated Government, at a percentage rate of 45% based on the American Metal Market Scrap Iron and Steel Price. A percentage price will be paid by the Contractor to the City and will be deposited into the Government Wide Revenue Account.

Public Works estimates approximately fifty (50) tons of scrap metal is received monthly. Typical items may include large metal auto parts and home appliances such as: refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, furnaces, air conditioners, heat pumps, hot water heaters, etc. The vendor shall also remove other miscellaneous scrap metal items from various departments on an “as needed” basis.

The contract term shall be for two years, with the option to renew for three additional twelve-month periods, contingent upon the mutual agreement of the City and Contractor.

Bid specifications were posted on the web pages of the Purchasing Division, DemandStar and Georgia Procurement Registry. Two (2) bids were received on January 20, 2021. This bid has been advertised, opened and reviewed. The bidders were:

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN ANNUAL CONTRACT WITH SA RECYCLING, LLC (EAST POINT, GA), FOR THE REMOVAL, RECYCLING/REUSE OF SCRAP METAL, BULKY ITEMS AND SIMILAR MATERIAL FROM THE COLUMBUS LANDFILL, AND OTHER CITY LOCATIONS OF COLUMBUS CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT, AT A PERCENTAGE RATE OF 45% BASED ON THE AMERICAN SCRAP METAL MARKET SCRAP IRON AND STEEL PRICE. THE PERCENTAGE PRICE WILL BE PAID BY THE CONTRACTOR TO THE CITY AND WILL BE DEPOSITED IN THE GOVERNMENT WIDE REVENUE ACCOUNT.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF COLUMBUS, GEORGIA, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an annual contract with SA Recycling, LLC (East Point, GA), for the Removal, Recycling/Reuse of Scrap Metal, Bulky Items and Similar Material from the Columbus Landfill, and other City locations of Columbus Consolidated Government; at a percentage rate of 45% based on the American Metal Market Scrap Iron and Steel Price. The percentage price will be paid by the contractor to the City and will be deposited in the Government Wide Revenue Account: Integrated Waste Management Fund – Government Wide Revenue – Government Wide Revenue – Recycling Fees; 0207-099-1999-REVN-4558.
