It is requested that Council approve the purchase of One (1) 4,000 Gallon Water Truck for Public Works Department from Yancey Brothers (Austell, GA) in the amount of \$193,745.00. The purchase will be accomplished by cooperative purchase via Omnia Partners Contract #212816-01.

The vehicle will be used at Pine Grove Landfill for dust suppression to help with visibility and air quality; as well as, to facilitate soil compaction for safer working conditions and assist with fire suppression. This is a replacement vehicle.
