The Historic Preservation Division (HPD) has received the document entitled, *Amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement Between Columbus Consolidated Government and the Georgia State Historic Preservation Officer Regarding the Demolition of 2610 16th Avenue, Columbus, Muscogee County, Georgia, HP-200526-004*.
