It is requested that Council approve the purchase of fifteen (15) Z930 Zero Turn Mowers for Public Works from Deere and Company (Cary, NC) at a unit price of \$12,174.48 and a total cost of \$182,618.20. The purchase will be accomplished by cooperative purchase via Georgia State Contract #99999-001-SPD0000177-0026.

The mowers will be used by the Public Works Department to cut grass on the right of ways throughout Columbus Consolidated Government. The mowers are replacement units.

Georgia Statewide Contract #99999-001-SPD0000177-0026 is a cooperative contract whereby Deere and Company. (Cary, NC) is one of the awarded vendors contracted to provide Tractors, Mowers and Earthmoving Equipment. The term of the contract is good through May 31, 2027. The contract is available for use by any Georgia governmental entity. The City's Procurement Ordinance, Article 9-101, authorizes the use of cooperative purchasing.
