

**AMENDMENT TO
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT
BETWEEN COLUMBUS CONSOLIDATED GOVERNMENT AND THE
GEORGIA STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICER
REGARDING THE DEMOLITION OF 2610 16TH AVENUE, COLUMBUS,
MUSCOGEE COUNTY, GEORGIA

WHEREAS, the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) was executed on August 11, 2021, with a five (5) year duration and an expiration date of August 11, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Columbus Consolidated Government (CCG) has not yet completed mitigation activities in accordance with Stipulation I of the MOA and proposes an extension of the MOA's duration in order to complete mitigation activities; and

WHEREAS, the CCG will send a copy of this executed amendment to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation (ACHP);

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with Stipulation V of the MOA, the CCG and the Georgia State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Amend Stipulation II [Duration] so it reads as follows:

This Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) will expire if its terms are not carried out within six (6) years from the date of its execution. Prior to such time, the Columbus Consolidated Government may consult with the other signatories to reconsider the terms of the MOA and amend it in accordance with Stipulation V below.
