**Recommendation:** Approval is requested for the Community Care Program, formally known as the Indigent Care Program, for the medically underserved and inmate population of Muscogee County, including a Community Care Program Administrator and the issuance of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for a Third-Party Administrator (TPA).

<u>Background:</u> The contract for Indigent Medical Care with The Medical Center Hospital Authority of Columbus, Georgia expired on June 30, 2022. RFP No. 24-0009 was issued for a consultant to assist with the development of the Community Care Program. PYA, P.C. was selected per Resolution No. 145-24. PYA, P.C. has developed the model to provide medical services to the underserved and inmate populations of Muscogee County.

<u>Analysis:</u> The Community Care Program will provide program administration and oversight, to include a Community Care Program Administrator (Pay Grade 128, \$66,810.59-\$103,510.83), medical/mental health providers, ancillary services, and Columbus Fire/EMS Correct Care Program.

**<u>Financial Considerations</u>**: The funds are available in the Community Care Program Fund.

<u>Legal Considerations:</u> The City Attorney will review all contracts associated with the Community Care Program.
