It is requested that Council authorize the execution of a construction contract with Woolford Contracting Company, LLC. (Fortson, GA) in the amount of \$94,280.00 for the Baker Center Driveway project.

The Community Reinvestment Department is requesting the services on behalf of Girls, Inc. of Columbus & Phenix-Russell.

The scope of work includes cutting, removing and disposing of damaged asphalt driveway, to include concrete curbs, removal and disposal of tree roots beneath the damaged driveway and installation of either a concrete or asphalt driveway surface able to withstand daily driving of passenger vehicles and 15-passenger buses weighing between 5,000 – 6,000 lbs. This is a U.S. Department of Housing and Urban development (HUD) funded project, which utilizes Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding. Woolford Contracting Company, Inc. shall adhere to all HUD and CDBG project requirements including Section 3, which is a provision of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968.
