Per Resolution #85-16, Council authorized an upgrade from an old mainframe system to the cloud-based Advantage360 Solution through a SaaS (Software as a Service) agreement. CGI has advised that support for all clients on the Advantage360 platform will be discontinued in the near future. Therefore, we are required to upgrade to the latest version of the software which is Advantage 4.0 per the original SaaS agreement.

Upgrading to 4.0 will provide a more user-friendly environment for all users. The 4.0 environment allows users to tailor the system to the components they use most frequently. The functional upgrade of this software is covered under the SaaS agreement. However, there are technical components that would require more consultation, training and technical support from the vendor which are the costs that will be negotiated.

The implementation for the upgrade will begin during the final quarter of 2020 and will span through the second-third quarter of 2021. The live date will be contingent upon the implementation process in 2021.
