It is requested that Council approve the purchase of an in-car mobile video recording system for the Columbus Police Department from Prologic ITS (Acworth, GA) by Cooperative Purchase via Federal GSA Contract #47QTCA19D00MM, in the amount of \$1,275,522.06.

The in-car mobile video recording system will be installed in patrol cars. This system includes cloud-based storage and management software, as well as all hardware, software, installation, and deinstallation of old equipment. The in-car mobile video recording system will integrate with the Police Department’s body camera system, which Council approved for purchase on June 15, 2021, per Resolution #186-21. The two systems will be managed together in one system and storage location. This system has been vetted by the Columbus Police Department and the IT Department.

General Services Administration (GSA) is the Federal purchasing cooperative providing products and services for purchase by state and local governments. The City’s Procurement Ordinance, Article 9-101, authorizes the use of cooperative purchasing.

Funds are available in the FY23 Budget as follows: \$1,233,336 from Other Local Option Sales Tax Fund – Public Safety – Police – Public Safety LOST- Capital Expenditures/Over \$5,000; 0102 – 400 – 9900 – LOST – 7761; and \$42,186.06 from General Fund – Police – Field Operations-Capital Expenditures/Over \$5,000; 0101-400-2300-FILD-7761.
