It is requested that Council approve the purchase of two (2) shade structures for Britt David Park and Rigdon Park from Hasley Recreation Inc. (Flowery Branch, GA), in the amount of \$71,461.08 each and a total cost of \$142,922.16. The purchase will be accomplished by cooperative purchase via Sourcewell Contract #010521-LTS-6.

The shade structures will be installed at Britt David Park and Rigdon Park and will be used to cover exercise equipment. This is new equipment consists of a 36' x 68' fabric canopy mounted on 6 columns for each park. This will provide a substantial amount of shade for users of the facility and reduce the temperature of the exercise equipment to be installed under the canopies. The modern look of the canopy will also enhance the overall appearance of the facility with a fresh, updated look.

This purchase will be accomplished by Cooperative Purchase via Request for Proposal (RFP) #010521, initiated by Sourcewell, whereby USA Shade/PlayPower, Inc. was one of the successful vendors contracted to provide Playground and Water Play Equipment with Related Accessories and Services.
