SUBJECT: Muscogee County Juvenile Court

INITIATED BY: Columbus Office of Crime Prevention

Recommendation: Approval is requested to enter into a one-year contract with Muscogee County Juvenile Court to award funding for Crime Prevention initiatives.

Background: Columbus Office of Crime Prevention has agreed to recommend the funding of \$20,000.00 to Muscogee County Juvenile Court in effort to the purpose of the Juvenile Court is to administer justice through the comprehensive delivery of services to children and families, victims of crimes, and the community so that children reach their full potential, victims of crimes are restored, and families/children are reunified.
