SUBJECT: Kingdom Sports

INITIATED BY: Columbus Office of Crime Prevention

Recommendation: Approval is requested to enter into a one-year contract with Kingdom Sports to award funding for Crime Prevention initiatives.

Background: Columbus Office of Crime Prevention has agreed to recommend the funding of \$5,000.00 to Kingdom Sports in effort to provide positive outlets for youth, fostering life skills, and offering a sense of community and belonging, thereby diverting at-risk individuals from criminal activities and violence.
