SUBJECT: Goodwill Industries of Southern Rivers

INITIATED BY: Columbus Office of Crime Prevention

Recommendation: Approval is requested to enter into a one-year contract with Goodwill Industries of Southern Rivers to award funding for Crime Prevention initiatives.
