**SUBJECT:** Columbus Technical College – Job Training Program

**INITIATED BY:** Columbus Office of Crime Prevention

**Recommendation:** Approval is requested to enter into a one-year contract with the Columbus Technical College to award funding for Crime Prevention initiatives.

**Background:** Columbus Office of Crime Prevention has agreed to recommend the funding of \$150,000.00 toward the effort to employ non-violent felons and reduce the rate of recidivism.

<u>Analysis:</u> Funds will be used to pay for the screening and training of non-violent felons to enable them to gain employment.

<u>Financial Considerations</u>: These funds are appropriated from the Other Local Option Sales Tax, Crime Prevention Program and do not require a match.
