SUBJECT: Enrichment Services

INITIATED BY: Columbus Office of Crime Prevention

Recommendation: Approval is requested to enter into a one-year contract with Enrichment Services to award funding for Crime Prevention initiatives.

Background: Columbus Office of Crime Prevention has agreed to recommend the funding of \$20,000.00 to Enrichment Services in effort to eliminate poverty and empower low-income individuals and families to achieve economic independence and self-sufficiency.

<u>Analysis</u>: Funds will be used for early childhood education, workforce development, housing assistance, and family support programs.
