AGENDA SUMMARY:	Approval is requested to submit an application and accept, if awarded, the FY 27 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). The FY 27 LMIG allocation for Columbus-Muscogee County from GDOT is \$2,915,074.60. A 10% local match is required.

Recommendation: Approval is requested to submit an application and accept FY 27 Local Maintenance and Improvement Grant (LMIG) funds from the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT). The FY 27 LMIG allocation for Columbus-Muscogee County from GDOT is \$2,915,074.60 with a 10% local match requirement.

Background: LMIG is the GDOT program that provides funding to counties for resurfacing and other capital transportation projects. The proposal is to use FY 27 funds to resurface the streets shown below. Depending on actual construction costs at the time of resurfacing, this list may be changed.
