## CDBG-CV Project Eligibility

Funds may be used to cover or reimburse allowable costs to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus and its impact on local communities through partnerships with non-profit agencies to administer programs directly to individuals.

Proposed CDBG Activities must meet the CDBG National Objective of:

Benefitting low to moderate-income persons;



# CDBG-CV Implementation Timeline Key Dates:

- Wednesday, July 8<sup>th</sup>: Webinar for interested parties
- July 13<sup>th</sup> July 24<sup>th</sup>: Application will be open to be completed and submitted.
- Tuesday, August 11<sup>th</sup>: City Council vote on recommended projects.
- Monday, August 31<sup>st</sup>: Issuance of Notices To Proceed.



### CDBG-CV Application Process

- The application will be open to be completed and submitted between July 13<sup>th</sup> – July 24<sup>th</sup>
- Applications will be completed and submitted online and will be accessible via the Community Reinvestment page on the city's website as well as the Facebook Page
- All applications must be submitted electronically by July 24<sup>th</sup> at 11:59PM.
