It is requested that Council approve an inspection service agreement for PoolPak® units from Hesco HVAC Equipment Service Company (Roswell, GA) for the annual amount of \$28,992, 50% payable at the beginning of the agreement and 50% at 6 months from the start date. The agreement will renew on the anniversary date of the agreement with the cost subject to a possible 3% annual escalation and price adjustment. Rates for additional work performed outside of the agreement will be billed at \$135 per hour for normal hours and time and one-half for weekends and holidays, plus parts.

The PoolPak® System has three units that work collectively as one unit. This system dehumidifies the air, cools the building and heats the water to accommodate the swimmers. Hesco will perform monthly and annual inspection/services on the three (3) PoolPak® units at Columbus Aquatic Center. This service agreement will ensure the units are working properly so the pool remains open for use by the public and for tournaments.

Hesco is the service entity for the Hill Company. Hill Company is currently and has been the PoolPak® authorized dealer in Georgia since 1987, and Hesco is certified and trained to perform maintenance and repairs on the system. Consequently, the vendor is considered an only known source for this purchase, per the Procurement Ordinance 3-114.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN INSPECTION SERVICE AGREEMENT FOR POOLPAK® UNITS FROM HESCO HVAC EQUIPMENT SERVICE COMPANY (ROSWELL, GA) FOR THE ANNUAL AMOUNT OF \$28,992, 50% PAYABLE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE AGREEMENT AND 50% AT 6 MONTHS FROM THE START DATE. THE AGREEMENT WILL RENEW ON THE ANNIVERSARY DATE OF THE AGREEMENT WITH THE COST SUBJECT TO A POSSIBLE 3% ANNUAL ESCALATION AND PRICE ADJUSTMENT.
