# COLLECTION OVERVIEW

#### **Normal Work Schedule**

- 4 Ten Hour Days/Week
- Spring and Summer Storms
  - Yard and Bulk Waste Collection increase in the Spring
    - 2019 Spring and Summer: Multiple Storm Debris Moratoriums
      - Worked 6-days/week July-August 60+hours/week
    - April 2020-Storm Debris Moratorium-Green Waste
      - Worked 6-days/week since April- Bulk Waste 60+hours/week

#### COLLECTION OVERVIEW

Spring/Summer Season:

Green waste tonnage increases



- Worked 5-days/week since Early June 50+ hours/week
- Worked 6-days/week since July 60+hours/week



#### COLLECTION CONSTRAINTS

- Additional tonnage is produced
  - brush and trees due to annual storm season
  - summer growth; brush pruning, grass clippings
  - MORE waste due to citizens being at home

- Delays due to:
  - Truck & Grab-all repairs-aging fleets
    - Average 20 garbage trucks down daily
    - Average 4-6 Graball trucks down daily
  - Employee absences; vacancies, vacations, illness, personnel issues
  - Inmate Labor
    - Shortage
    - Transportation

#### COLLECTION CONSTRAINTS

- Stresses to current fleet size-collections of 14k-15k households each day
  - 14 yard waste routes versus 27 Refuse trucks
  - 10 bulk waste routes
  - Subsidizes HHG routes when needed
    - 2 to 4 trucks per day if needed
- **COVID Constraints** 
  - April 2020-Reinstatement of Yard Waste April 27
  - June 2020-Reinstatement Non-Green Bulk Waste June 1

# COLLECTION FOCUS

- Household Garbage
  - Federally mandated-once a week service
  - ~56k households; 4 collection days
  - 27 trucks, 27 FT drivers, shares 2 PT drivers
- Yard Waste
  - CCG mandated-once a week service
  - 14 trucks, 14 drivers, 1 PT driver

- Recycling
  - CCG mandated-once a week service
  - 14 trucks, 14 drivers, 2 PT driver
- Bulk Waste
  - CCG mandated-once a week service
    - Green and Non-green bulk waste
    - 10 Trucks

# COLLECTION FOCUS

#### • Collections

- Yard Waste
  - Wednesdays and Saturdays
  - 6 to 8 drivers, 14 to 16 inmates
  - 1 supervisor; new mandate -all work
- Bulk Waste
  - Wednesdays and Saturdays
  - 7 to 9 drivers, no inmates
  - 1 supervisor
  - Supplement with Forestry & Streets
    Division

#### • Landfills

- Wednesdays & Saturdays
- 3 to 4 employees
- l supervisor



### INTEGRATED WASTE CONCERNS

- Garbage fee does not cover Cost of Services
  - Inability to purchase replacement capital outlay equipment
  - Inability to add staff to increase fleet size for Yard Waste and Recycling
    - Growth of subdivisions in North Columbus
    - Growth of Recycling participation
    - Growth of Green and Non-Green bulk tonnage

#### INTEGRATED WASTE CONCERNS

- Staff Safety
- Longer days, six days per week, leads to driver exhaustion
- High driver turnover
- Inmate participation
- Inmates request to return to prison by mid-afternoon
- Inmate exhaustion in summer heat and winter cold

#### COLLECTION ALTERNATIVES

 We currently have several vendors on contract that provide emergency pick up services. We're in the process of determining when they can start assisting us with Yard Waste pick up.

#### CONCERNS AND SOLUTIONS

- Funding is not available for:
  - Replacement equipment for Landfill, Collections, and Recycling Center
  - Division growth to match Collection area growth
  - Landfill closure and post closure
  - Recycling Center operations beyond FY23
- Solutions
  - Look at options for sizing services to garbage fee limitations
  - Increase fees to match current services
  - Implement a delicate balance of adjusting services & fees

#### HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE TRUCKS

- Replacement Schedule Rule; Refuse Truck, 7 years
  - Refuse Truck Inventory
    - FY21 replacement needs at current service levels: 7 trucks, \$1.2M, Rear Loader
    - Current Inventory of HHG Trucks: 30 trucks; 3 fleets, 9 trucks each plus 3 spares. 27 FTE Age:
      - 1 > 15 years-Spare
      - 1 > 14 years-Spare
      - 1 > 13 years-Spare
      - 1 > 12 years
      - 2 > 9 years
      - 1 = 7 years
      - 23 < 7 years

12 HHG Deadline

Growth needs: 36 trucks; 10 trucks each, 6 spares. Add 3
 FTE: 12 trucks, \$2.1M, Rear Loaders

#### RECYCLING TRUCKS

- Replacement Schedule Rule; Recycling Truck, 7 years
  - Recycling Truck Inventory
    - FY21 replacement needs at current service levels: 12 trucks, \$2.1M, Rear Loader
    - Current Inventory of Recycling Trucks: 15 trucks (16 needed); 2 fleets, 7 trucks each plus 1 spare. 14 FTE

#### Age:

- 2 > 15 years-Spares
- 9 = 7 years
- 4 < 4 years

4 Recycling Deadline

• Growth needs: 18 trucks; 8 trucks each, 2 spares. Add 2 FTE: 14 trucks, \$2.45M, Rear Loader

#### YARD WASTE TRUCKS

- Replacement Schedule Rule; Yard Waste Truck, 7 years
  - Yard Waste Truck Inventory
    - FY21 replacement needs at current service levels: 3 trucks, \$525k, Rear Loader
    - Current Inventory of Yard Waste Trucks: 17 trucks; 2 fleets, 7 trucks each plus 3 spares. 14 FTE

#### Age:

- 2 > 14 years-Spares
- 1 = 7 years
- 14 < 7 years

• Growth needs: 18 trucks; 8 trucks each, 2 spares. Add 2 FTE: 6 trucks, \$1.05M, Rear Loader

#### **BULK WASTE**

- Replacement Schedule Rule; Grab-All Truck, 7 years
  - Grab-All Truck Inventory-Needs (Green and Non-Green Waste)
    - FY21 replacement needs at current service levels: 5 trucks, \$750K
    - Current Inventory of Grab-all: 12 trucks; 2 fleets, 5 trucks each plus 2 spares. 10
       FTE

#### Age:

- 1 > 11 years
- 4 = 7 years
- 7 < 7 years

• Growth needs: 14 trucks; 6 trucks each, 2 spares. Add 2 FTE: 7 trucks, \$1.05M
